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What is Bravo Agristo?

To celebrate our 40th anniversary, we are bringing colleagues from all our European sites together for a fun family day. Enjoy a large inflatable park, a mini festival with live performances for all ages, craft corners, face painting, temporary tattoos and many other activities for the whole family. Of course, plenty of food and drinks will be available.

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Where and when does it take place?

The Family Day takes place at Brussels Gate on Saturday 26 September from 12:00 pm to 8:30 pm.

You are free to arrive and leave whenever it suits you.

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Why Brussels?

For our 40th anniversary, we want to bring colleagues from all European sites together in one central and easily accessible location.

In addition, the venue allows all planned activities to take place both indoors and outdoors, ensuring the programme can go ahead regardless of the weather.

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Who can I bring?

All Potatoholics may bring their partner and all children living at home.

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We don't officially live together.

No problem. Partners are welcome regardless of whether you share the same address.

I'm single and/or don't have children living at home.

Colleagues without a partner may bring **one additional adult and up to three children**. Colleagues bringing their partner but no children may also bring **up to three children**. These guests must be registered as partner and/or child.

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Blended family

Your partner's children living at home are also welcome, even if they do not permanently live at the same address.

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How can I register?

Register via the event page on myAgristo until **12 September 2026** (inclusive).

After registering, you will receive a confirmation email allowing you to modify or cancel your registration until that date.

After 12 September, please email marketing@agrsto.com for any changes to your registration or bus transport.

I'm leaving Agristo before the family day.

If you leave Agristo before 26 September, your registration will automatically be cancelled.

I'm working on Saturday 26 September. Can I still be part of the Family Day?

If you are scheduled to work and cannot attend, a food truck will be available at every site so you can enjoy a meal during your shift.

If you can join before or after your shift, you are more than welcome.

Freelancers and external staff

Freelancers, external staff and project workers may attend if they

- have worked for Agristo for at least three months by the event date and
- spend at least 50% of their working time at Agristo.

If you do not meet both of these conditions, you will unfortunately not be able to register for the Family Day.

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12 How do I get there? By bus

Buses will depart from our sites in Wielsbeke and Tilburg

- Outbound: 11:00 am and 1:00 pm
- Return: 6:00 pm and 8:30 pm
- Bus transport is free of charge but must be reserved during registration.

By public transport

Brussels Gate is easily accessible by public transport:

Tram: line 19

Bus: lines 82, 136, 213, 214 et 355

Train: direct train from Brussels to Groot-Bijgaarden station (the station is located at the rear of the event venue's car park).

You may also travel by car; ample parking is available.

13 Are vegetarian, vegan or halal options available at the food trucks?

Yes. A variety of meal options will be available. When registering, you can indicate your dietary requirements and any allergies.

14 Is there a cloakroom or a place to leave a stroller?

Yes. Lockers will be available where you can safely store your personal belongings. There will also be a designated area where you can safely leave strollers during the Family Day.
